
A 5-year-old boy presents with abdominal distention, billous vomiting, and obstipation. A plain abdominal radiography as shown below:



What is your diagnosis ? Click for anwers

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The plain abdominal radiograph shows generalized bowel dilatation with evidence of multiple opaque tubular structures in the intestinal lumen (arrows). There is no evidence of bowel perforation.

Diagnosis: Interestinal Ascariasis with bowel obstruction
