A preschool child presented with acute abdominal pain, arthralgia, skin rash and lower gastrointestinal bleeding. Colonoscopy was performed:



What is your diagnosis ?
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Diagnosis: Henoch-Schonlein Purpura

The colonoscopy revealed colonic mucosal erythema with multiple erosions, resulting from vasculitis. The patient responded well after treatment with prednisolone.

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
