A school-age boy presents with chronic abdominal pain for 4 months. There is no clinical improvement after being treated with antisecretory agents and prokinetic drugs. EGD is performed. This picture shows pathology at the antrum:



What is your endoscopic diagnosis ?

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Diagnosis: Nodular antritis (antral nodularity)

This finding is consistent with *Helicobacter pylori* infection.

Urease test and histopathology would be helpful for establishing the definite diagnosis. Compared to adults, duodenal ulcers are less frequently observed in children.

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
